



Greyhound Stadium Facility Guidelines

Greyhound Stadium, as a multi-purpose facility, serves the University overall, ENMU athletics department, and the Portales Municipal Schools. Through the various services offered, it stands to create, foster and maintain a positive experience for athletics, athletes, sporting events, and fans alike.

A. Stadium Reservations:

1. All facility request must be submitted to the office of stadium operations. Reservations included but are not limited to: Athletic practices, competitions, and other related activities. This includes practices for the visiting team. Reservations can be made online at: <http://ressnet.enmu.edu/enmu>
2. Staff members are NOT authorized to request facilities without reserving through the online system or the stadium operations office.
3. Stadium usage by outside groups must also go through the online system or the stadium operations office.

B. Event Security:

1. ENMU Police reserves the rights to remove any person(s) from the stadium
2. Greyhound Stadium is equipped with 24-hour surveillance around and inside the stadium. ENMU Police will also have officers/security station in and around the stadium.
3. All stadium security personnel will go through the ENMU Police department. **Note:** No outside security personnel will be allowed without the permission of the ENMU Police Chief or staff
4. The University Chief of Police will determine the amount of security needed per event held at or around the stadium.
5. Jobs and descriptions will be set forth per the Eastern New Mexico University Specials Events Guidelines.

C. Seating

1. Greyhound Stadium has reserved seating for specific groups.
 - Green Back chairs are reserved for Greyhound Club members and those who purchase season tickets.
 - Left "Wing" (when looking at the stands) is reserved for the ENMU Band
 - Lower middle section is reserved for students.

D. Alcohol

E. Advertisement

On Event days, no person will be permitted to advertise, promote, sell tickets, or collect funds for any purpose without the written permission of the ENMU Athletic department.

F. Field of Play and Track

1. Only those in possession of a sideline or "All access" pass will be permitted on the field or track, before, during or after the game.
2. Seeds (sunflower, pumpkin, etc.) or confetti are not permitted on the field or track
3. Motorized vehicles are prohibited on the field, except for ENMU authorized vehicles

G. Key access to the Stadium

1. Access will be given in accordance to ENMU key policy
2. Stadium Director and Staff will have keys
3. ENMU AD will decide who receives keys and which keys they receive
4. Portales AD will be the only personnel to receive keys

H. Concessions

1. ENMU Baseball will operate concessions at all football events and will adhere to the Concessions Policies and Guidelines
2. ENMU Baseball will split net revenue at Portales High School events, 50/50.
3. PHS will coordinate concessions for track and field meets in which they host.
4. Policy will be reviewed at the conclusion of each academic year.
