



Student Research and Creativity Conference

- **What is it?** The ENMU Student Research and Creativity Conference.
- **When is it?** Wednesday, **April 3, 2019**. The entry deadline is Friday, **March 1** so plan ahead. (No late entries will be accepted)
- **Who can enter?** Undergraduate and graduate students from all disciplines at ENMU can participate. There's no cost to present at the conference.
- **Where does it take place?** Poster and visual art presentations are in the Campus Union Building. Paper presentation and fine arts performances take place in various rooms across campus.
- **How can I participate?** Presentation categories include papers, posters, fine arts performances, and visual artwork. You can present research or creative work you've completed or something you're still working on. Last year, nearly 200 students presented.
- **How will I be evaluated?** Presentations are judged and critiqued by an interdisciplinary group of faculty members.
- **Why should I participate?** You'll be able to compare your work to that of other students on campus. You'll get valuable presentation experience and feedback on your work and your presentation skills. This presentation can serve as a dress rehearsal for other presentations you'll give in class, at a professional conference, or on the job. You can list the conference on your resume or CV. There's a free banquet for participants, and cash prizes will be awarded.
