New Business:

 - Thoughts of “having time to review packets from departments”
 - Encouragement to be active in meeting
 - Agreements and/or disagreements are equally important
- Tabling review of CDIS until next meeting
 - Cole/Waldo (8 for /0 against)
- Submissions are largely editorial in nature
 - RELG
 - Changed related to course description only
 - No changes to minor at all
 - Dropping five courses in order to streamline program
 - Consolidating

 - RELG 2510 to Odd Fall only
 - RELG 1123
 - Changed from Fall/Spring to Fall only
 - MOTION to approve as proposed and with confirmation of “minor changes only”

 - MATH
 - Rest of CDIS will come through laster
 - No changes to Gen. Ed.
 - No changes to curriculum
 - Editorial changes
 - Faculty
 - Removing pre-req. for MATH352
 - Change to secondary required courses
 - Choice of 352 or 371
 - Adding pre-req of 311 to 429
 - Change to description of MATH 2530 in order to match state syntax
 - MOTION to approve as proposed

- Waldo/Cole (unanimous)
 - ENG
 - Changes are straight forward
 - Memo is only 2 pages
 - No changes to American Languages and Cultures program
 - Doesn't not include Spanish
 - ENG lit. degree only
 - Clarifying writing minor
 - Technical and professional writing course
 - ENMU was originally done as a 300 level course
 - Moved to ENGL2210
 - NOW → moved BACK to ENGL325
 - Adding pre-req of ENG to 1000 to all 2000 level literature courses
 - MOTION to approve as proposed
 - Waldo/Cole (7 for/1 opposed – R. Schneider)
 - Brief discussion regarding validity of justification for changing from state Gen. Ed. Back to ENMU only course.

 - 03/16 preferred date to Academic Services
 - Allowed as far back as 03/30
