Page 12 paragraph 1 Change- Faculty are strongly advised not to publish in a journal listed in the "Blacklist" of Cabella Scholarly Analytics (see <https://www2.cabells.com/>) to Any article published in a journal listed in the "Predatory Reports" of Cabell's Scholarly Analytics (see <https://www2.cabells.com/>) will not be accepted by the COB. Faculty are responsible for providing documentation verifying the status of the journal at the time of manuscript submission. Such documentation will serve as evidence to be honored by the FEC and Subsequent level of appraisers for all future reviews.

I would like to have volunteers for an Adhoc committee to propose scholarship requirements- Koleyni and Stone volunteered.

Page 19. Change Table II and III.

II- Change the word section to folder in first sentence. le This folder contains all the original Faculty Change of Status Appraisal Forms from the previous review cycle.

III- Change the entire paragraph to read -This folder contains all the responses the faculty member made to any appraisals in the previous review cycle.
