1. Approve agenda: motion to approve by Dr. Good, seconded by Mrs. Lemke, all in favor
2. Approve minutes for May 5, 2021, May 27, 2021 and June 7, 2021: motion to approve by Dr. Good, seconded by Mrs. Lemke, unanimous approval with one abstention Dr. Baldock
3. Dr. Hurren proposed adding Ebony Cooper to the Council as a non-voting member due to her role as Alternative Licensure and Assessment Specialist, vote was taken with unanimous approval
4. Meetings will be held on the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays from 8:30-11:00 a.m.
5. Gateways to pathways: proposed revision to have all testing except one done by student teaching, motioned by Dr. Good, seconded by Mrs. Lemke, unanimous approval-pathway sheet will be updated and distributed
6. Teacher Education handbook presented by Kari Lemke, feedback is due by September 1, 2021
7. Kappa Delta Pi, Dr. Good suggested that ENMU require that students at least be through their first Education course
 - Dr. Kallus will discuss with Drs. Viner and Bengé
8. Lesson plan template was presented by Kari and Ebony, this is the standard template and will be used across the college
9. Student teaching hours need to be cleared up, Malisa will schedule another meeting with CET Council to work this out-after this meeting another will be scheduled with Dr. Balch
10. Announcements and updates:

 - After discussion all agree that the first pitch for the Isotopes event will be Morgan Rawson

18. Alternative Licensure updates
 - Ebony is creating an orientation for alternative licensure students
 - Dr. Evaniuck discussed the testing requirements for alt. licensure, Kari Lemke motioned for test completions to be done prior to the final internship instead of the first semester, seconded by Dr. Good, unanimous agreement
19. Dr. Davis, accreditation teams will be set by September
