1. Fall, 2021 semester overloads and under-enrolled courses. You may not get to teach overloads if you have a class with low enrollment. Low enrollment courses won't be allowed.
2. Viability Studies Update (tentative)-BCIS, AG BUS, and PFP. BCIS and PFP are ok. AG BUS -Dr. Gandonou-I teach five AG BUS classes and I'm the only one that teaches them all. I'm the only one that knows the students. Who intervenes with the VPAA? Dr. Hemley- Dr. Balch set up the committees for the viability study.
3. Canvas migration for summer
4. Building access-Let Kathie know if there are any issues. They are required to complete the daily health checkup. Ask once, 2nd time is a warning, third time let Kathie know.
5. Fall semester course delivery
6. Search updates-Ms. Wallace- Accounting search committee meet last Thursday. I will talk to the Chair about moving forward. Dr. Haney-Management/BUS Law search committee -We have 27 applications, 6 meets requirements. We will meet Tuesday and set up interviews.
7. Capstone course discussion – Bob Schneider-Dr. Luhman would like a break from teaching the graduate capstone class. Dr. Schneider will teach it. Dr. Cole will be teaching the undergraduate capstone class. Dr. Cole and Dr. Schneider acknowledges there is a problem with the way the courses are being graded. There is no consistency in grading. Dr. Cole- Fall 2019 was the last live presentation. Ten faculty showed up for one and eight showed up for the other. Spring 2020 we had to go to online presentations. Five faculty graded all of them and two additional faculty graded some of them. We need increased participation. Fall 2020 six faculty graded all of them. Here are the grades one group received-3 A's, 1 B, 1 D, 1F. All for the same presentation. The second group received 1 A, 2 B, 1 C, 2 F. All for the same presentation. We have to change the way we are grading the presentations. We have three or four options. 1) stay the same 2) instructor does the grading 3) functional teams-ACCT, MKT etc. Accounting faculty would grade the ACCT team etc. 4) peer evaluations. For Fall 2020 we had 10-12 graduate faculty each time. It is easier to watch online.
Dr. Burusnukul-recorded is easier to watch. Dr. Niu- I'm not a financial person so it limits my ability to grade. Dr. Corbin-the 3rd option will have the same problem we have now. Ms. Wallace Level of assessment as far as total grade. 20 % of their grade. Average of the scores the faculty gives them. Dr. Cole-We can redo the rubric. A broader perspective is the best, instead of small groups. Dr. Ying-We need to know what are the expectations of presentation. Tell us what they are. We need training on the rubric. Dr. Stone -grade what I know. Dr. Cole-Balance responses.

Dr. Kayhan-5% graded by other students. Dr. Cole is going to do this on practice presentations. Student grading has to be separate from assessment.

8. As may arise. Marketing should get another \$4,000 for recruiting. We are the only ones that used all of designated money for marketing. Congratulations to the committee.

Fall 2020 student evals. We don't have them yet. Should get them sometime this week.
