  - o New emphasis within existing program
  - o Not required to request approval from the state
  - o Will go into effect – Fall of ‘21
  - o Motion to Approve – Cole/Shuler (unanimous)
- Friendly Memo: Department of Theater and Digital Filmmaking
  - o Added already approved course at *REQUISITE* rather than *ELECTIVE*
  - o No way to require “class voice” at the current time.
  - o Not part of their learning objectives nor requisites
  - o Motion to Approve – Cole/Tompkins (unanimous)
- Thoughts regarding expanding Advising Modules
  - o Currently laying out “ideal” progression through degree/discipline
  - o Departments should look more closely at a FULL degree/discipline advising module(s)
    - Students can feel supported by faculty WITH use of these proposed expanded modules
