1. Remarks from the Dean-concerning our Pastries with the President- the VPAA doesn't have any money.

MOTION BY DR. LUHMAN, SECONDED BY DR. COLE: To change the distribution of travel money to \$750 each Tenured and \$1500 each Tenure Track. Dr. Snyder tabled the motion until he looks at the budget.

2. Rethinking MBA course deliver-There is a push for us to go to 8 week courses. They will pay outside source to market it. I want us to be in control of this. The VPAA wants changes implemented by Fall 2020. Our MBA can be completed in 3 semester if we go to 8 week courses. Flexibility is the driving force. Dr. Corbin stated that during the summer she loses about 25% of MBA students because they can't keep up. A survey should be given to see who would prefer to take the 16 week or 8 week course. Dr. Laurenz will meet with us at our next COB Faculty meeting to discuss further.
