### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Q: How can I get tickets?**

A: Call the ENMU Athletic office at 575-562-2153 or go by Greyhound Arena #45. Act soon. You can also visit the athletic web-site at [www.goeasternathletics.com](http://www.goeasternathletics.com) and click on the ticket tab.

ENMU Greyhound Football season tickets are also on sale now for home games. Tickets for individual games are \$10 per person. Military, military dependents and ENMU students have free admission with ID.

**Q: Is handicapped parking and seating available at Greyhound Stadium?**

A: Yes it is! Handicapped parking is located in Lot C (home side) and Lot D (visitors' side) of the Stadium, marked with blue handicapped parking signage. For handicapped-accessible seating, enter at the main plaza entrance (where the ticket booth is located). Seating will be on that same level.

**Q: Are there Reserved Season Tickets (seatbacks) for Football left?**

A: Yes, but hurry to select the best seats. Call the ENMU Athletic office at 575-562-2153 or go by Greyhound Arena room #45. You can also visit the athletic web-site at [www.goeasternathletics.com](http://www.goeasternathletics.com) and click on the ticket tab.

**Q: Do you have to be a Greyhound Club Member to purchase Reserved Season Tickets (seatbacks) for Football?**

A: Yes, this is a new change this year.

**Q: Is there any indoor seating?**

A: Unfortunately, there's is no indoor seating at this time. Fundraising for "Phase 2" of the Stadium will add a hospitality suite (with indoor seating) at the press box level, accessible by elevator.

**Q: What's the charge for parking at the Stadium?**

A: No charge.

**Q: Why should I purchase my tickets ahead of time?**

A: Lots of reasons!

- A very large crowd is expected for this Grand Opening Game and you can assure that you get a ticket before the game is sold out. This is expected to be the largest crowd at a football game in ENMU history.
- You can avoid traffic and assure a reasonable parking spot or tailgate area. Since this is all new you can get oriented.
- You can also avoid long lines at the ticket windows by purchasing tickets in advance.
- Purchasing tickets in advance allows you to show up at the tailgate parking lot and take part in the new tradition called the "Dawg Walk", which will take place approximately 1:45 ahead of kick-off. There will be other pre-game programming that you will want to make sure you are able to get through the gates onto the plaza and into the stadium to find your seat at least 45 minutes ahead of kick-off.

**Q: Can I park my recreational vehicle at the Stadium?**

A: Yes, you can! For assistance parking your RV, please contact ENMU Police at 575.562.2392. If you are calling after hours, the call will forward to the officer on duty.

**Q: I know the grand opening game is Sept 10 and the kick-off is at 7:00 p.m. What else is happening before the kick-off?**

Glad you asked! A lot is happening! Lot A (for tailgating) will open at 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, Sept 10. The "Dawg Walk" is at 5:40 p.m, a new tradition for Greyhound Stadium. The Greyhound Sound Marching Band also perform in the Plaza before the game.

The ceremony officially opening the new Stadium will begin at 6:15 p.m. Recognition of key donors will be part of this brief ceremony. The Greyhound Sound Marching Band will perform, and two co-captains (from the 1991 and the 1957 championship football teams) will join the ENMU team captains for the coin toss.

**Q: What is the Dawg Walk?**

A: It is a new tradition that will start on the day of the Grand Opening. The players will leave the football field house to walk to the stadium to begin warming up approximately 1:45 Minutes prior to kick-off. A new sidewalk has been laid leading from the fieldhouse to the stadium and it has green dog paw tracks painted on it. This sidewalk is located on the south side of the tailgate parking lot. This event is expected to take an organic development process and become a new tradition at ENMU. Generally speaking, it is expected that the fans and students will line both sides of the sidewalk and the spirit team will perform and the Greyhound Sound (marching band) will play as the team walks through this area to the stadium. It is expected to develop into a tradition that everyone will want to be a part of and everyone can be a part of for Greyhound Nation.

**Q: What else is happening at the Grand Opening?**

- After the Dawg Walk, the Greyhound Sound (marching band) will move to the plaza area to perform on the west side of the stadium as fans come through the gates.
- Beginning 45 minutes prior to kick-off there will also be pre-game opening ceremonies that will recognize dignitaries and special donors. ENMU hopes all of Greyhound Nation will help honor those that were most responsible for making this amazing project a reality.
- There will be amazing surprises just before kick-off, as well as the team entering the field through the tunnel of spirit squad and the Greyhound Sound. There is a special surprise unveiling of a new tradition tied to a special old tradition. Don't miss this!
- As half-time, there will be field and scoreboard dedications, donor recognitions, corporate game recognition, Greyhound Sound performs and marches, spirit squad performs, and much more.

**Q: Where is parking for the Greyhound Club members?**

A: Reserved parking for Greyhound Club members is on the south side of the Stadium, near the main entrance. Please bring your parking decal for entrance to this lot. To enter Lot C (Greyhound Club reserved parking), use the main entrance off W. University Drive. Halfway down the drive, a sign will direct you to “Lot C.” Turn left into Lot C.

**Q: What about overflow parking? Can we park anywhere else?**

A: Yes. Greyhound Arena parking lot will be open for parking as well. A shuttle will be provided for those needing assistance getting to the Stadium. The Stadium is in a residential area, so street parking will be very limited.

**Q: Where can I tailgate? Do I have to reserve a space?**

A: **Tailgating with alcohol** is permitted only in Lot A (Tailgating) and only at ENMU Greyhound football games. As you enter the Stadium, drive all the way to the end of the drive for access to Lot A. Parking in the tailgate area is first-come, first-served. Tailgating without alcohol is permitted anywhere in the Stadium parking.

**Q: I don't know the area where the Stadium is located. How do I get there? Is there street parking?**

A: The Stadium is in a residential area, so street parking will be limited. The best place to park is in one of the Stadium parking lots or at Greyhound Arena, which is east of the Stadium. Lot D (Visitor parking) is open to all. Lot A (Tailgating) is reserved for those tailgating with alcohol. Lot B (Family parking) is open to all. Lot C (Greyhound Club) is reserved for Greyhound Club members. There is no charge for parking at Greyhound Stadium or at Greyhound Arena.

To get to the Stadium, enter (from the north) from Fir Street and come south to the Stadium down North Ave O to W. University Drive. Turn right. Lot D will be on your left and Lots A, B, C can be accessed at the main Stadium entrance on W. University Drive, 500 feet to the west.

If you are arriving from Highway 70, turn north at the light on W. University Drive and follow the curve across the railroad tracks to Lot D (on your left) or stay on University to the main Stadium entrance (turn left for Lots A, B, and C).
