Note: At least 18 hours of courseowrk must be taken in classes taught in Spanish. Native speakers take SPAN 2210 SPAN 2220, or SPAN 330 for a total of 6 hours. Non-native speakers take SPAN 2110 and 2120 for a total of 6 hours. Combine these 6 hours with the Spanish requirements below in the minor for a total of 18 hours.
