1. Approve agenda: motion to approve by Dr. Good, seconded by Mrs. Lemke, all in favor
2. Approve minutes for March 3, 2021 and March 10, 2021: motion to approve by Dr. Good, seconded by Dr. Kallus, unanimous approval
