The acceptance and transfer of coursework will be based on an analysis of each student's transcript. Only coursework designated as transfer credit may be considered for the primary concentration. Should the student decide to change degrees, any transferred career or technical courses would no longer apply toward a baccalaureate degree.				SECONDARY CONCENTRATION AREA (24-33 hours): An approved field of study consisting of a minimum of 24 hours. Concentration must include at least 15 hours of upper-division (300-/400-level) courses. Each course must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher. The secondary concentration is intended to complement the student's vocational or technical background and broaden career opportunities. The secondary concentration/emphasis areas are only available to students who are pursuing the BAAS degree.
