NURS 516: Roles, Responsibilities and Relationships of the Nurse Educator

Course Goal

To introduce graduate level students to the roles, responsibilities and relationships of nurse educators.

Course Description

Roles, responsibilities and relationships which are part of the nurse educator in both academic and health care settings. Major topics include professional development, using evidence to improve teaching, cultural diversity, scholarship related to teaching, balancing role demands, collaboration and advocacy.
