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PREFACE

The Institutional Research Office is pleased to make this Electronic Factbook available for 2017. Through the years 1980-2016, the University Office of Institutional Research has developed this resource as a compendium of selected facts and frequently requested current and historical information about the University.

This 2017 effort represents the final compilation of a printable PDF version of the ENMU Electronic Factbook. We will continue to leave this and all other historical Factbooks available for download. Users are reminded and cautioned though, that the data reflected in those may not be entirely accurate to, consistent with, or replicable by current data definitions and reporting practices.

The specific purpose of this preface section is to assist users by explaining the anticipated evolution forward of this document called “Factbook” --- in a way that will enable members of the university community to more readily access the data types that they are seeking.

Our commitment here is to transitionally provide web links within this electronic factbook document that will deliver users to newly developed Institutional Research Office Portal Pages where information of that specific type are compiled. These Portal Page links deliver users to uniformly formatted data displays that are multi-year comprehensive, Fall/Spring/Summer Term inclusive, and which universally reflect data for both the Portales and Ruidoso campuses.

Users already familiar with the ENMU Factbooks of 1980-2016 will quickly notice that many pages and several major sections have been renamed / reorganized or eliminated entirely from Factbook 2017. Be assured though--as the opportunity for displaying more robust arrays of Fall, Spring, and Summer data is dispatched to IRO portal pages instead--nothing much is being eliminated so much as migrated out and transformed in the interest of comprehensivity, integration, and coherence.

What remains in this last Factbook 2017 are just those “old school” displays that users have specifically requested to be configured in the same familiar way.

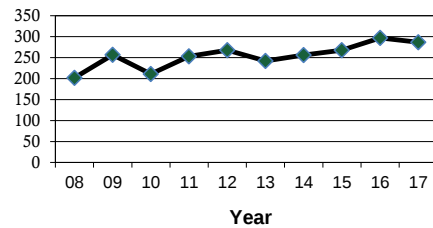

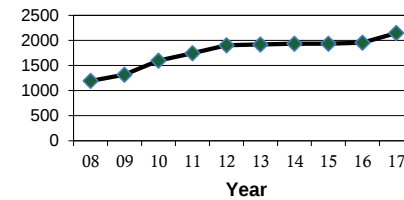

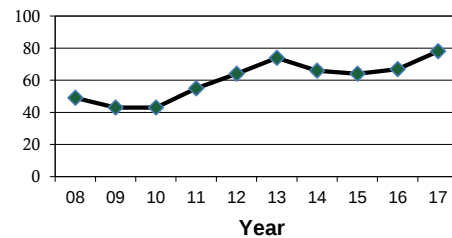
African American 2008-2017



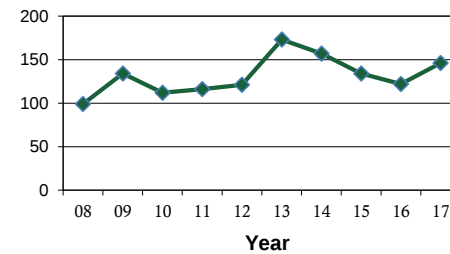
Hispanic 2008-2017

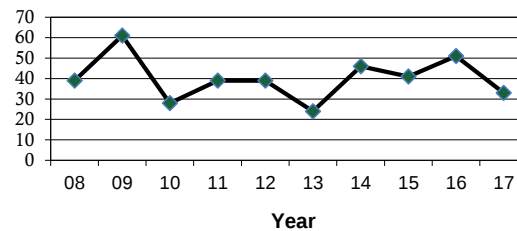

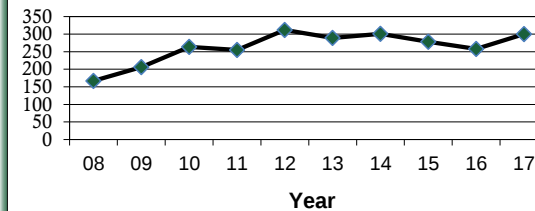

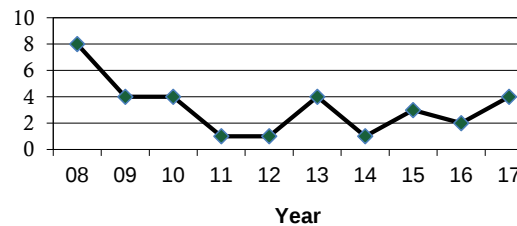
Afr. Amer. F. T. Freshmen 2008-2017



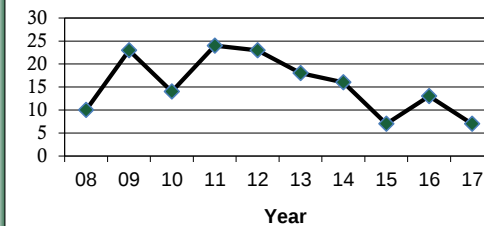
Hispanic F. T. Freshmen 2008-2017

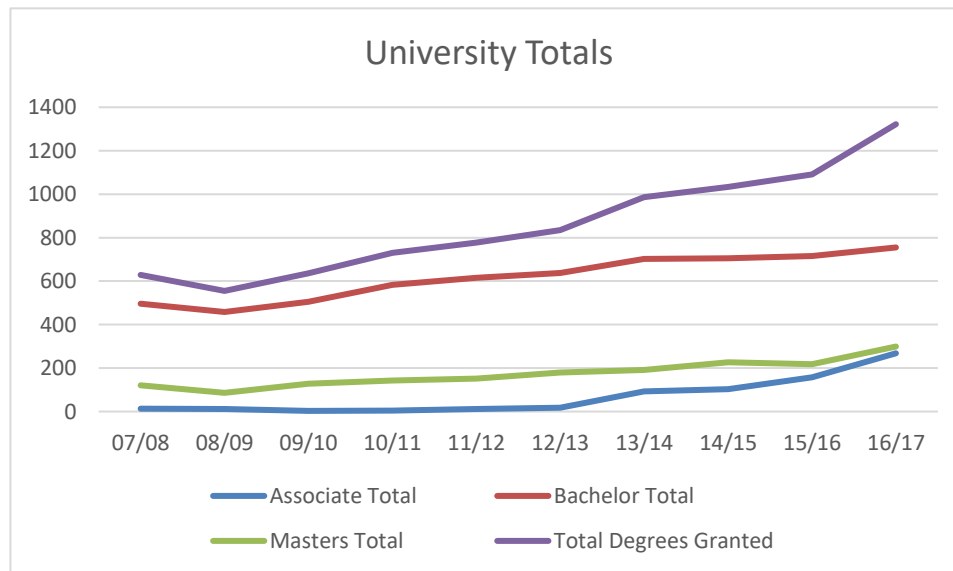
