Festival Location	ENMU Greyhound Stadium W University Drive Portales, NM 88130
Arrival Time	Bands should arrive 60 minutes prior to the assigned performance time. Check-in at west entrance of Greyhound Stadium. Guides will meet you upon arrival at Greyhound Stadium.
Band Check-In	A check-in table will be marked and visible at the west entrance of Greyhound Stadium. Please check-in before parking your buses.
Bus Parking	Buses will park in the west stadium lots. Guides will be assigned to each band and will direct your drivers to the unloading/ loading zones.
Restrooms	Plenty of restrooms are available in Greyhound Stadium, but please have students change into uniforms on buses.
Equipment Unloading	Any equipment that will not be needed in the warm-up area may be unloaded in the east stadium parking lot and rolled down the ramp to the stadium surface. Equipment vehicles may park in the northeast stadium parking lot.
Warm-Up Area	All bands will use the same natural grass athletic practice field (west of Greyhound Stadium) for musical and visual warm-ups. An observation tower is available. Lighting will be provided. Bands will face west when playing.
Staging Area	A guide will inform the director when it is time to depart the warm-up area for the staging area.
Field Exit	A guide will lead the band onto the track and into the west stands.
Press Box Admission	Adjudicators and contest officials are permitted in the press box throughout the festival. Band directors will be admitted to the press box following their band's performance for a 10–15 minute huddle with the adjudicators.

Field Markings	Al Whitehead Field at Greyhound Stadium runs north to south. NCAA markings are observed. Sideline and yard lines (10 yard increments) are clearly marked. Temporary high school hash marks will be provided.
Festival Rules	As the Green and Silver Classic is a formative and educational festival, we have only two festival rules: <b>BE KIND AND BE RESPECTFUL</b> . Naturally, all bands are expected to follow the official festival schedule.
Show Enhancements	Use of any material which could leave residue of any kind on the field or in the air is prohibited.
Pyrotechnics	Pyrotechnics are prohibited in Greyhound Stadium.
Power Access	Power outlets are available at field level on the home sideline.
Adjudicators	Adjudicators will be located in the press box at approximately the 30 (2) and 50 (1) yard lines.
Awards Presentation	As the ENMU Greyhound Sound Marching Band enters the Greyhound Stadium, drum majors should make their way to the track (west 50-yard line) to gather for the awards presentation.
Performance Recording	Each director will be provided with a complimentary jump drive that will contain an HD recording of your ensemble's performance.
Seating	Bands and patrons will sit on the west (press box) side of Greyhound Stadium.
Admission	Although patrons are admitted to the Green and Silver Classic free of charge, a \$1 per patron donation is suggested to help offset costs.
Concession Stand	The Portales High School band boosters will operate the concession stand. Meals are available for your students/staff by contacting Kelli Morrison via email at kmorrison@portalesschools.com.
